



# January "2024" Birthday Blessings





#### **Epiphany**

The word epiphany has a variety of meanings intimately related to one another. Epiphany means the shining of a light, a shining forth, a manifestation, an appearance, or a revelation.

The Festival of the Epiphany apparently had its origin in the east at the beginning of the third century. By the end of the third century, January 6 had become the accepted date for the celebration of the festival. At that time, Epiphany Day commemorated the birth of Jesus, His Baptism, and His first miracle at Cana in Galilee. At the outset, it was a splendorous, multifaceted commemoration.

In the middle of the fourth century, the Western Church moved the celebration of Christmas as the birthday of Jesus to December 25. Therefore, the Epiphany festival took on new meaning for the western, and many eastern, churches. In the west, the visit of the Wise Men came to have the position of prominence on Epiphany day, and, in time, other events of the day were assigned to the Sundays of the Epiphany season.

#### The Transfiguration of Our Lord

(from Rev. Stephen Preus,) "Luther's use of the Transfiguration to teach the hope we have in the resurrection of the body is truly wonderful, for when you hear the vivid picture of "

how Jesus' "face shone like the sun, and his clothes became white as light" (Matthew 17:2),

Luther's treatment of the Transfiguration finally focuses on the Holy Trinity. "The whole, holy Trinity appears here to strengthen the believers; namely, Christ in his transfigured form, the Father in the voice, and the Holy Ghost in the bright cloud. "In your baptized life you are learning more and more who your Triune God is, how He works for your good, three Persons in one divine unity.
